Garage Products can be harmful to your health

Many spray cans you have in your garage can contain dangerous chemicals with many of these products being available over the counter. As a part of using these products, Safety Data Sheets should be acquired from the vendor so you can better understand how to safely use and handle the product. **As a part of safe handling, latex gloves or nitrile gloves, if you have sensitivity to latex, should be used.** Some of the common products used in a garage include: gasoline, carburetor cleaner, chlorinated and non-chlorinated brake cleaner, electric motor cleaner, Loctite thread locking compounds and battery acid. **If you do get chemicals and compounds on your hands, due to the possible absorption through your skin, immediately wash your hands.**

Gasoline, as an example, contains organic solvents that can easily enter your body through your skin. Worse, gasoline contains Benzene, which is a proven carcinogen. Other products in gasoline such as Toluene can cause damage to kidneys and liver.

Carburetor Cleaner contains a "cocktail" of dangerous and powerful solvents. Most of these are highly volatile and pose a toxic inhalation danger and must be used with adequate ventilation. Avoid using these products in closed garages.

Brake Cleaner, both chlorinated and non-chlorinated, contain solvents that enter the body through skin or inhalation and may cause cancer, attack the central nervous system and attack kidneys and liver. They also pose a real fire hazard.

Fortunately, many of the dangers these chemicals present can be reduced or eliminated with a few simple safety precautions. Wash your hands thoroughly after handling chemicals. Avoid touching your face. Wash your work clothes separately from other clothes. Use latex or nitrile gloves, safety goggles designed for chemical use.

They can be acquired through Grainger or a good Hardware store. When using solvents, make sure there is plenty of ventilation and fresh air in the work place. Be sure to keep your work area clean and protect yourself.






